Application Details

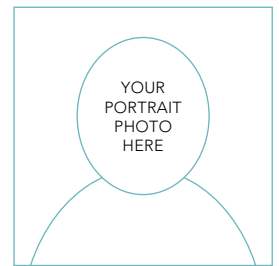
- Applicants must be aged 15–17.
